Re: Ohio Administrative Rules 5139-61, 5139-63 and 5139-36-03

You are receiving this message pursuant to the requirements of Executive Order 2011-01K and Senate Bill 2 of the 129<sup>th</sup> General Assembly, which requires state agencies, including the Department of Youth Services, to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by SB2), and provide opportunity for the affected public to provide input on the rules.

You are being asked to review and comment if necessary on OAC Chapter 5139-61-03,04,07,09 and 10, **Community Juvenile Corrections Facilities**, OAC Chapter 5139-63-03,04,05,07,08,09 and 10, **Fiscal Rules for Community Juvenile Corrections Facilities** and OAC 5139-36-03, **Fiscal Management**.

The purpose of these rules are to outline the Administrative and Fiscal responsibilities for Community Juvenile Correctional Facilities.
