

# Findings from Cuyahoga County's Behavioral Health/Juvenile Justice (BHJJ) Initiative

**371 youth have been enrolled since 2006**

51% are male, 61% are nonwhite, & the average age is 16.2 years

At intake, common diagnoses include: ADHD, Cannabis-related Disorders, and Alcohol-related Disorders

**68% of youth successfully completed treatment**

Average length of stay in the program was 11 months



**BHJJ led to nearly a 70% reduction in risk for out of home placement**



**Treatment led to significant improvements in functioning & problem severity**



**Over 96% of youth were NOT sent to an ODYS institution following services**



**Youth reported significant reductions in trauma symptoms and substance use**

Problems with substance use decreased by nearly half!



**Across Ohio, BHJJ costs about \$5,000 per youth compared to \$200,000 to commit a youth to ODYS**



**Grades improved & school suspensions/expulsions were greatly reduced**
