Call to Order

Judge Stucki opened the meeting and welcomed new members. Members introduced themselves.

Membership Update

New members were again recognized and welcomed to the SAG. Linda Janes stated that she was pleased to have new members and that she was continuing to work with the Governor's Office to expand membership.

Inside DYS

Director Reed stated that the DYS population is down to 486 from over 1000 youth. He stated that DYS is changing the way it does business. Seclusions are down about 89 percent from 200 hours per month to less than 4 hours per month, and violence has been reduced by 27 percent. Ms. Janes stated the DYS budget is even and this will allow for more reinvestment in the community.

About the Governor's Council

Judge Stucki gave an overview of the purpose of the Governor's Council and why it exists. He explained, OJJDP, the JJDP Act, and the role of the Governor's Council in the grant award process.

Title II Funding Status

Kristi Oden explained that the application was in process and is due by June 1. She also stated that per the previous three-year plan, funds will continue to be used for compliance with the JJDP Act.

Program Monitoring

Dion Baines stated that he has been conducting onsite monitoring visits at the funded programs. A list of active programs is included in the folder.

Compliance Status and Changes

Danny Turek stated that compliance report data is due by June 30. He explained that data is currently being compiled for the report and alerted members the report timeframe had changed, which will require him to collect data quarterly rather than semi-annually.

DMC Status and Data Review

Kristi Oden stated that UC is nearing completion of the state DMC assessment with the report being due by June 30. Keith William explained that he is currently collecting 2015 data from juvenile courts and law enforcement agencies.

General Business

Member determined the June 3rd meeting will be held at Lighthouse at Paint Creek. Linette Fout will make the onsite arrangements.
